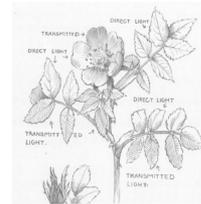

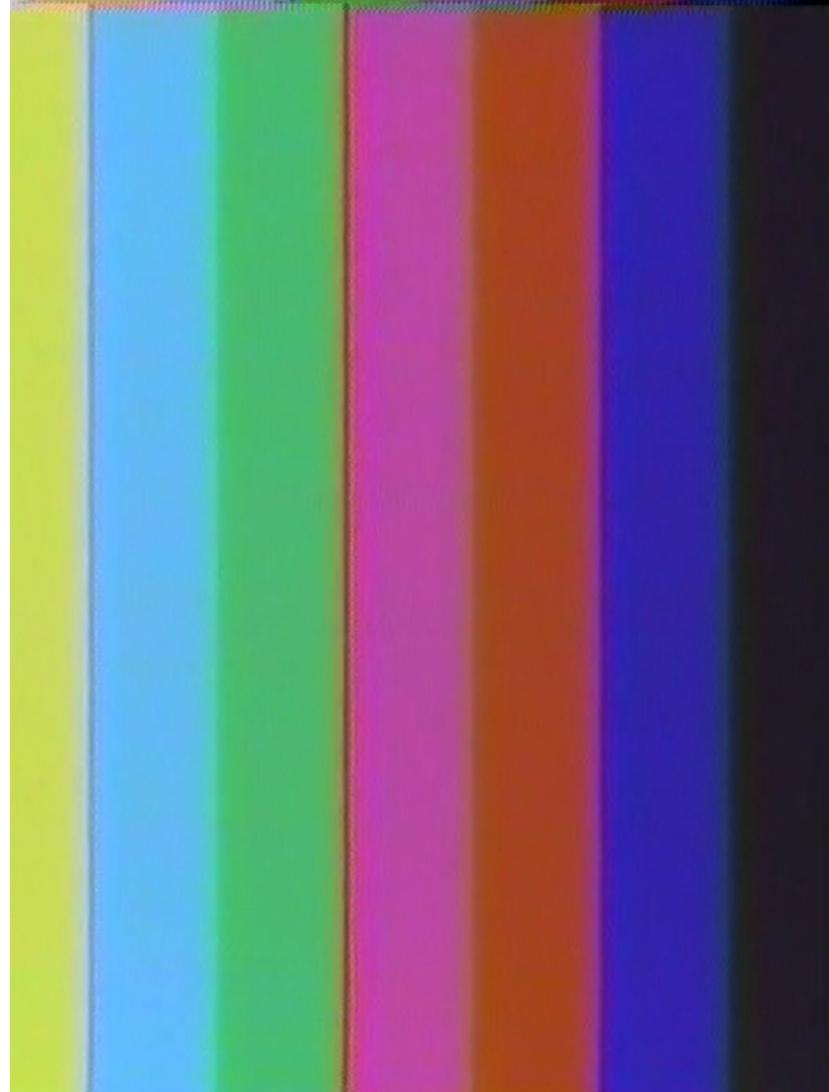
Creating a Dream Plan

- Pricing out hardware
- Imagining a dream repository
- Asking questions: “How will a user interact with this? How much material do we have? what materials should be included? How can we incorporate information students and information literacy into the final product?”
 - These initial steps were crucial in taking advantage of a “now or never” moment, and getting in a proposal.

So This Is Happening?!

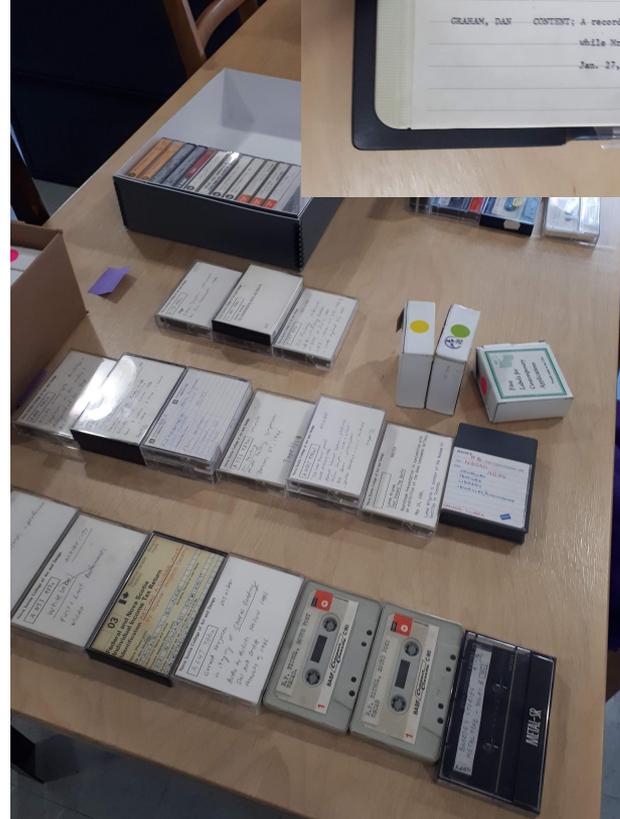
New AV Repository building with Discovery Garden: NSCAD Key Components:

- Student workflow for depositing thesis
- Ability to present MFA Film theses in a dynamic way to show the materials in context with one another
- Ability to incorporate many types of media as needed



Other Materials to be Included

- **Library media collections**
 - Digitized archival video and film
 - Audio Collections
- **NSCAD created radio shows**
- **Faculty scholarship**



Lessons Learned So Far

- Bring in the experience and expertise of colleagues.
- Describe and advocate for everything you need to do the project right, in as much detail as possible the first time.
- It's good to have a plan for those dream projects
